1000 wybitnych antropologów z 75 krajów słucha profesora Michała Buchowskiego, otwierającego Kongres Międzynarodowej Unii Nauk Antropologicznych i Etnologicznych IUAES 2019 Poznan. Wyjaśniając tytuł "World Solidarities" rozpoczął opowieść o jego źródle od 1956 roku i reakcji władzy na bunt robotników: zmanipulowanych procesach sądowych, kampanii propagandowych oszczerstw i konsekwentnemu skłócaniu społeczeństwa.
